Imagine holding your next business meeting, conference or retreat at a scenic mountain getaway surrounded by majestic pines and breathtaking views – with staffed food service, dorm-style cabins with fireplaces, health center, hiking trails, outdoor amphitheater with stage and campfire ring, and a spacious lodge with high-beamed dining hall, recreation/ conference room and fireplaces.

Located in the San Bernardino Mountains on National Forest Service land, AbilityFirst Camp Paivika is a versatile venue available for rental; offering comfortable, contemporary accommodations for up to 130 people. Only 30 minutes from the high desert and just 20 minutes from San Bernardino, the Inland Empire and Lake Arrowhead, Camp Paivika is a practical destination for one-day events, as well as multiple-day conferences and retreats.

Built in 1947 as one of America’s first recreational camps for people with disabilities, Camp Paivika is fully accessible to wheelchair users and others with special needs. We welcome people of all abilities.

Camp Paivika has five modern cabins each providing the following accommodations and amenities:

- 4 cabins-each sleeps 22; 1 cabin sleeps 32
- Coin operated washer and dryer
- Carpeted

- Fully accessible bathrooms and showers
- Lockers for valuables



Main Lodge

- Dining hall with 195 maximum occupancy
- Full food service
- Heated
- Large recreation room that includes television VCR/DVD, two pool tables, and ping pong and foosball tables
- Large fireplaces in both dining hall and recreation room
- Fully accessible restrooms located adjacent to the dining
