AbilityFirst is pleased to announce the final phase of its capital campaign to renovate the Lawrence L. Frank and Long Beach Centers. To date, AbilityFirst has raised over \$5.5 million, more than 97 percent of its \$5.9 million capital campaign goal. We have only \$204,000 left to raise.

The Building Independence, Celebrating Community capital campaign will transform how our programs are delivered at the newly renovated Lawrence L. Frank Center, and at the Long Beach Center. These sites are the central hubs for our expanding Supported Employment, ExploreAbility, PossAbility, College to Career, and After-School program.
